


 - ☐ FARM









AGRICULTURAL REVOLUTION

- SELECTIVE BREEDING
 - ☐ AVERAGE WEIGHT OF CATTLE
 - □ 1710: 169 KG (368 LBS.)
 - □ 1795: 363 KG (800 LBS.)
- MARLING: ADDING A MIXTURE OF CLAY AND LIME TO THE SOIL; USED AS FERTILIZER IN LIME DEFICIENT SOILS.
- ☐ BONE MEAL AS FERTILIZER. (PHOSPHOROUS)





- USE OF COKE MADE PRODUCTION CHEAPER
- ☐ 1800S: USE OF STEEL PASSED IRON
 - ☐ STRONGER BUT MORE EXPENSIVE
- BESSEMER CONVERTER: INVENTED BY HARRY BESSEMER AND MADE STEEL LESS EXPENSIVE



d. TRANSPORTATION

- ☐ 1815: GEORGE STEPHENSON INVENTED THE FIRST STEAM POWERED LOCOMOTIVE
- BY MID-1800S STEAM SHIPS SURPASS SAILING SHIPS
 - ☐ REQUIRED A NETWORK OF SUPPLY STATIONS AROUND THE WORLD



CHILD LABOR	☐ WAGE EARNERS




MANCHESTER ENGLAND, 1840

LUDDITES

- ENGLISH CRAFTSMEN WHO BELIEVED
 THAT MACHINES WERE EVIL BECAUSE
 THEY PUT PEOPLE OUT OF WORK
 - THEY ATTACKED AND DESTROYED FACTORIES AND THE MACHINES IN THEM
 - ☐ NAMED FOR GENERAL NED LUDD WHO FOUNDED THE MOVEMENT
 - ☐ ARMY OF REDRESSERS







MODERN LUDDITE: TED KACZYNSKI, THE UNABOMBER

LUDDITES

- ☐ 1812: FRAME BREAKING ACT MADE IT A CAPITAL OFFENSE TO DESTROY A MACHINE
- GOVT. SENT IN 12,000
 TROOPS TO DESTROY THE
 LUDDITE MOVEMENT
- ☐ 17 MEN WERE HANGED
- ☐ THE MOVEMENT FIZZLED OUT









ECONOMIC & SOCIAL THINKERS

ADAM SMITH

- ☐ FATHER OF CAPITALISM
- WROTE WEALTH OF NATIONS
- ☐ ARGUED FOR LAISSEZ-FAIRE ECONOMICS
 - ☐ LAISSEZ-FAIRE = LEAVE IT ALONE OR LET IT BE
 - BELIEVED THE GOVERNMENT SHOULD NOT INTERFERE IN THE ECONOMY
- ☐ ARGUED FOR RELIANCE ON THE 'INVISIBLE HAND' OF THE MARKET








THOMAS MALTHUS

- WROTE AN ESSAY ON THE PRINCIPLE OF POPULATION
- ☐ FIRST PROFESSIONAL ECONOMIST
- ☐ ARGUED THAT POPULATION GROWS AT A FASTER RATE THAN FOOD PRODUCTION
 - ☐ POPULATION GROWS EXPONENTIALLY
 - THUS HE ARGUES THAT THERE WOULD ALWAYS BE POVERTY. IT WAS UNAVOIDABLE.






DAVID RICARDO


1748 - 1834

- ☐ KNOWN FOR HIS "IRON LAW OF WAGES"
- ☐ IF POPULATION INCREASED, WAGES WILL FALL.



IF POPULATION DECREASED, WAGES WILL TEMPORARILY RISE BUT THEN PEOPLE WILL HAVE MORE CHILDREN AND POPULATION WILL INCREASE.




BOTH RICARDO AND MALTHUS OPPOSED GOVERNMENT HELP FOR THE POOR.


JEREMY BENTHAM

 - ☐ EQUAL RIGHTS FOR WOMEN











JOHN STUART MILL

Distribution of Wealth, U.S. Households, 2004




Many people began to see capitalism as the Source of Suffering and all that was wrong with society.


KARL MARX

- ☐ PhD in history & philosophy
- ☐ German but lived and wrote in London
- ☐ Works:
 - ☐ Communist Manifesto with Friedrich Engles
 - □ Das Kapital
- □ believed that history is pushed along by class conflict (Dialectical Materialism)
- ☐ "from each according to his abilities, to each according to his needs"
- ☐ Proletariat: people who have nothing to offer but their labor
- ☐ Bourgeoisie: middle/upper-middle class





